To use a lab or tutorial for academic support, simply ask your teacher in that subject area for a pass. You may use labs during your Study Halls (after attendance is taken, with permission for your Study Hall teacher), during your lunch, or during a period such as 1 or 9 when you do not have a class. The signed pass is important because it helps us identify what our students need and serves as attendance record for our labs in the event of an emergency. Be sure to sign in to the lab when you get there! Should you come to school early (before Period 2) to go to a lab, be sure to sign in upon entry to CHS at the front desk before proceeding to the lab or library.
