This popular course will give 11-15 year olds the knowledge, skills and confidence to care for infants and school-age children. Training consists of videos, activities, and hands-on skill training and discussions. This course teaches how to respond to emergencies, illness-es, first aid, rescue breathing, appropriate care of children, decision-making skills, and child development. Each individual will receive an American Red Cross Certification Card upon completion. Materials, lunch and snacks will be provided.

All certified babysitters are encouraged to volunteer to gain babysitting experience for their resume. There is always a need for volunteers and future YMCA staff.
