Study Halls do not meet on exam days. Science labs do not meet during the exam days. In the event that a student has three major exams on the same day, the student may request permission to schedule one of the exams on an alternate day. Such arrangements must be completed before June 10 with communication between the student and the teacher. Students do not report to school during their lunch period.

Breakfast service for students ends at $8: 15$. There is no supervision in the cafeteria during the lunch period exams. Students should only report to school during the Period 5, 6, and 7 exam periods if they have an exam during that time.

The 10 minute passing time between exams is designed to permit students to use the restroom or go to their lockers, if necessary.
Students who are absent from an exam must present a written excuse from a parent or guardian to their dean in order to have their absence excused. The student is then responsible for contacting the teacher as soon as possible to schedule a make-up exam. Make-ups are held in the exam day afternoons.
