**AN ORDINANCE
TO
DIRECT THE INSTALLATION
OF A STOP SIGN
ON MIDLAND BOULEVARD
AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH
SUMMIT AVENUE**

"Interpretive Statement"

This Ordinance will direct the installation of a stop sign on Midland Boulevard at its intersection with Summit Avenue.

WHEREAS, the Township of Maplewood ("Township") Engineering, Public Works and Planning Sub-committee requested that the Engineering Department perform a study to determine whether a stop sign was appropriate for the intersection of Midland Boulevard and Summit Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department found that the roads in question are under municipal jurisdiction and therefore do not need New Jersey Commission of Transportation approval for the installation of a stop sign; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineering Department, using the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, did a study and determined that a stop sign at the referenced intersection does meet the necessary requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineering Department recommends that a stop sign be installed on Midland Boulevard at its intersection with Summit Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that:

FIRST:

1. A stop sign be installed on the northwest corner of Midland Boulevard at its intersection with Summit Avenue;

2. The Township Department of Public Works install the aforementioned stop sign as a permanent traffic control as soon as practical.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after final passage and publication and as provided by law.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title for the first time at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on Tuesday, July 19, 2016, 7:30 p.m., at the Maplewood Police and Court Building, 1618 Springfield Avenue, Maplewood, New Jersey, and that Committee met again on Tuesday, August 2, 2016, at 7:30 p.m., at the Maplewood Police and Court Building, 1618 Springfield Avenue, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Committee proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on second reading and final passage.
