South Mountain Soccer, Fall 2017 Boys & Girls



South Mountain Soccer registration is now by AGE, not grade, in conformance with revised New Jersey Youth Soccer rules and regulations. Registration is open to players born 2004-2009.

South Mountain Soccer is a recreational soccer program which offers a wide range of opportunity to players at all levels in the fall and/or spring seasons. There are no tryouts. Teams are formed randomly and participate in the InterCounty Youth Soccer League (ICYSL) against teams from nearby communities. The ICYSL divisions include U10, U12 and U14 as follows:

- U10 division includes players born in 2008 and 2009 (see note below)
- U12 division includes players born in 2006 and 2007
- U14 division includes players born in 2004 and 2005.

U10 NOTE: If registration in the U10 divisions is sufficient, consideration will be given to forming an in-town South Mountain soccer league **for U10 teams ONLY.**

Please Note: High School Varsity players and travel team carded players are **NOT** eligible to participate in the InterCounty Youth Soccer League. The ICYSL has a High School age division/s. If sufficient interest exists we will sponsor a team. Interested players should send an email to pcoleman@southorange.org with the player's name, date of birth and contact info.

FALL SEASON: The fall soccer season is tentatively scheduled to begin late August/early September. Players will be contacted by a volunteer coach regarding team placement and their schedule in mid-August. All teams practice with professional trainers once a week on either Tuesday or Thursday (time and day to be determined by registration levels) and generally play one game per weekend.

REGISTRATION: Soccer registration **begins July 1st** and children are enrolled on a first-come, first served basis. The registration **deadline is July 15th** OR when the program full, whichever comes FIRST.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$215. This fee includes a \$20 per player fee that is dedicated to future field restoration and improvements. All players receive a complete uniform (shorts, jersey and socks).
