July Fireworks. Central Dispatch made notification to Irvington PD requesting mutual aid for crowd control as the crowd began to approach the Irvington / Maplewood border. Several IPD Officers arrived on scene and began to assist. As the crowd approached Elmwood Ave. and Meadowbrook Pl. the undersigned observed one black male who was later identified as, [REDACTED] spit on the abdomen of IPD Officer, Michael Johnson #465. At this time the undersigned along with Johnson attempted to place [REDACTED] in custody at which time he began to pull away and resist from Officers control and refused to comply with Officers verbal commands.

The undersigned was then forced to place [REDACTED] in a compliance hold, specifically by holding his left arm with pressure behind his back, at which time [REDACTED] was taken to the ground with the assistance from Johnson. While on the ground attempting to gain control of [REDACTED] who had his right arm tucked under the right side of his body, and was kicking both of his legs, the undersigned was able to gain control of [REDACTED] left arm which was able to be handcuffed. Both the undersigned and Johnson continued to attempt to gain control of [REDACTED] right arm who continued to resist officers verbal commands and officers control. At this time the undersigned again placed [REDACTED] in another compliance hold, specifically by applying pressure to his left arm and left wrist which was behind his back, and Johnson was able to gain control of [REDACTED] right arm which was then handcuffed. [REDACTED] was then placed in custody and later transported to MPD HQ for processing in marked patrol vehicle 4-11 by Ptl. Lawson and IPD Officer King. YAB Det. Sgt. Palmerezzi and Det. Raith were notified who will follow up with charges for [REDACTED]

Upon completion of processing, Cynthia McDougall ([REDACTED] Mother) responded to MPD HQ signed for and took custody of [REDACTED]

from Parker Ave. and Valley St. (where a large fight had occurred), all the way up to Elmwood Ave. and Franklin Terr. (Irvington Border).

At this time we were at the intersection of Orchard Rd. and Elmwood Ave. when multiple subjects from the crowd became extremely irate and refused to comply with any orders to get out of the roadway. During that time one female in particular was enticing the crowd to not comply with officers orders. Officer Rodrigues then approached the female and guided her to the sidewalk, at which point the above stated suspect [REDACTED] grabbed Officer Rodrigues' hand and attempted to pull him away from the female. At that time, Officer Ferraro #386 then grabbed [REDACTED] and pulled him away from Officer Rodrigues (refer to Officer Ferraro's narrative for further). During that time I observed the other above stated suspect [REDACTED] attempt to over take an officer that was assisting Officer Ferraro with [REDACTED] I then attempted to place [REDACTED] in a pain compliance hold by bending his wrist and arm, and guide him to the ground which he began to resist (while hanging onto another Officers body). I then struck [REDACTED] approximately (3) times in the abdomen/side of his body with a closed fist which I was then able to get him onto his stomach and place his hands behind his back and into handcuffs.

[REDACTED] was then placed into the rear of patrol vehicle 4-4 by Officer Gearen #380 and myself which he remained secured in the vehicle until we were able to get the scene under control and the crowd dispersed. Officer Gearen and I then transported [REDACTED] to Police Headquarters for processing. [REDACTED] was charged with Obstruction, Disorderly Conduct, and Resisting Arrest.

[REDACTED] sustained minor injuries to his face, arms, and side during the course of arrest which he was seen by the Maplewood FD in the line up room, which he was being non compliant with them and refused to talk.

While in the line up room [REDACTED] continued to be disorderly and combative by shouting profanities and challenging myself and other Officer's. [REDACTED] then stood up out of anger and spit onto the floor in the direction of Officer Rodrigues and myself which he was then placed into handcuffs for both of our safety, and removed from the line up room. [REDACTED] was then able to calm down and the handcuffs were removed where he came back into the line up room and cleaned up his spit.

Officer Ferraro #386 and I then transported both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to their residence where they were released to the custody of their grandfather (Kassim Ali).

On 7/5/16 at approximately 2250hrs, I (Ptl. Ferraro) along with other Maplewood officers were providing crowd control from the July 4th fireworks display. During that time, officers were conducting crowd control of a large disorderly group from Valley St. and Park Rd., all the way to Elmwood Ave. and Franklin Terr. (Irvington border). As officers were attempting to clear the large group out of the roadway on Elmwood Ave., a few subjects started to become highly irate and began to shout profanities. Furthermore, the few subjects became completely uncooperative, and failed to follow officers orders to remain out of the roadway.

During that time, I observed one of the subjects [REDACTED] shouting profanities, and approach Ptl. Rodrigues #384 as he was guiding a female subject out of the roadway towards the sidewalk. [REDACTED] then grabbed Ptl. Rodrigues' hand and attempted to pull him

away from the female. At that time, I immediately grabbed [REDACTED] and pulled him away from Ptl. Rodrigues, at which time he became highly irate and immediately pushed away from me. At that time, I went to grab [REDACTED] again and place him under arrest for disorderly conduct, at which time he took a fighting stance and stated, "Nah fuck that". At that time, I began to wrestle with [REDACTED] as I attempted to take him into custody. During that time [REDACTED] attempted to break free from my control, at which time myself and other patrol officers took [REDACTED] to the ground in order to place him under arrest. While on the ground [REDACTED] continued to combative towards officers, and refused to comply with our verbal commands. As I attempted to place [REDACTED] into handcuffs, he pinned both of his arms underneath his body, and refused to put them behind his back. At that time, I struck [REDACTED] on right-side of his torso with a closed fist and then applied a pressure point technique behind his ear, in order to gain control of his arms and subdue him.

At that time, these officers were able to get [REDACTED] hands behind his back, and placed him into handcuffs. [REDACTED] was then escorted over to marked patrol vehicle #4-14, and searched incident to arrest (which yielded negative results for any weapons and or contraband). [REDACTED] was then transported to HQ for processing by Ptl. Jones #379 in unit #4-14. It should be noted, that [REDACTED] had sustained minor cuts and scrapes to his face and arms as a result of wrestling with officers while on the ground. [REDACTED] was later evaluated by the MFD while at HQ, and refused any medical attention (at which time Ptl. Jones signed-off on the medical aid refusal form). In addition [REDACTED] was subsequently charged with disorderly conduct and resisting arrest. [REDACTED] was later transported to his residence [REDACTED] by Ptl. Isetts #404 and I in marked unit #4-4, and turned over to his guardian (Kassim Ali). Let it be noted, that Ali signed-off on all of the proper juvenile forms.
