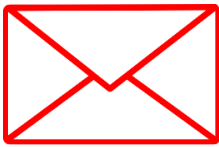


# NJ GENERAL ELECTION COVID-19 RESPONSE

## Automatic Vote-by-Mail

The election will be conducted primarily via vote-by-mail ballots, which will be sent to all active registered voters on September 28th. All ballots will have prepaid return postage.



## Deadline for Voter Registration

The deadline to register to vote is October 13<sup>th</sup>. Make sure to check your voter registration status by visiting [nj.gov/state/elections](https://nj.gov/state/elections), and clicking on "[Am I Registered?](#)"

## Polling Locations

Community Center at DeHart Park

Any voter who chooses to cast their vote in-person will do so using a **paper provisional ballot**. All individuals with disabilities will have access to an ADA-conforming voting machine.



## Returning Vote-By-Mail Ballots

Voters will be able to return ballots:

- by mail (postmarked by 11/03)
- by depositing it in a secure drop box (by 8pm on 11/03)
- by handing it directly to a poll worker at a polling place on Election Day (signature required and you may only drop off your own ballot)

## Checking if your Ballot was Received
