Essex County Public Health Recommendations

• Get a flu shot! It's best to get vaccinated in September or October, but you can get vaccinated into January.

- Follow good respiratory hygiene recommendations.

• Stay home if you are sick and avoid sick people.

• Review and follow CDC travel advisories when planning travel. If you become ill after returning home to the United States, call your healthcare provider before going to a doctor's office or emergency department of a hospital. Wear a cloth or disposable mask when entering the building to protect others.


