


<u>High School-Social Work Intern</u> <u>Program</u>

The High School Social Work Intern Program places graduate school social work interns into CHS to provide a full range of counseling services for students and their families.

Interns meet with students on a voluntary basis with the consent of their guardian, to address every day age appropriate struggles. This is a tier 1 low level intervention. If a student requires more assistance, referral can be made to another school professional (SAC, ESS) or to a community provider.

Referral Process:

Student Assistance Counselors

The Student Assistance Counselor (SAC) aims to help students and their families by encouraging healthy coping alternatives. Students are encouraged to meet with the SAC for help with concerns such as alcohol/drug use, depression, anxiety, eating disorders, problems with peers, grief, or crisis. The SAC offers students a safe place to talk about any problems they may be having, aims to help students develop healthy coping skills, make positive life-style choices, and avoid substance abuse problems. Discussions are confidential and do not become part of school records.

Referral Process:

 Students can refer themselves or be referred by a parent or school staff member

Services Provided:

- Individual counseling
- Crisis intervention
- Substance abuse/prevention
- Referrals to outside providers
- Educational groups






Wear your mask all the way up, close to the bridge of your nose and all the way down under your chin. The mask should fit snug around your face without gaps.

Read the letter in order to follow our quarantine procedures, especially if you haven't sent in your vaccination paperwork to our nurses. Just know that you can still access the link through the letter.


