Educational Leadership Experience

Instructional Leadership

- Adjunct professor and curriculum developer for Centenary University, Educational Program.
- Organized and led a leadership team to develop the Somerset County Educational Summit, a county-wide professional learning opportunity for 500+ teachers, administrators, nurses, coaches, and aides to engage in each other's shared experiences and reflect on others' unique perspectives through professional development.
- NJPSA Aspiring Leader Council Founding Member organized Aspiring leader Conference
- Redesigned the Somerville Medical Sciences Academy(SMSA) to a 4-year cohort structure with Raritan Valley Community College to support expansion into CTE "development status" to increase equity between Somerville and Branchburg participation.
- Created an Academy Structure to support equity and access to STEM-focused fields, reducing prerequisites and providing clear pathways of electives for high school students.
- Developed a professional learning series that supported the transition from traditional to block schedule.
- Coordinated and led professional development for remote and hybrid instruction. Used data and vertical articulation meetings to identify and address standards, skills, and students in need of focused attention.
- Certified learning platform facilitator; Peardeck, Jamboard, Khan Academy Ambassador, EdPuzzle, Gizmos, Kami, which increased utilization of instructional technology.
- Codeveloper of *Teachers Teaching Teachers* (T3), a school-wide academy to provide meaningful, teacher centered professional development and implement LinkIt, a student growth, and data management system.

- Worked with the Director of guidance to design a Master schedule
- Codesigned *Somerville Stronge*, evaluation process to build clear, concise expectations for educators.
- Worked with the MTSS team to learn the implementation process and collaborated on strategies to support educators in their data collection and monitoring of student growth toward goals.
- As the SkillsUSA Advisor, I coordinated informational meetings and led the Career Technical Education PLC to design and implement a SkillsUSA program with our health sciences, computer science, and engineering educators to enrich our academy programs.
- Developed curriculum for new equity initiative, eliminating “intro-level” classes and replacing them with college preparation level classes supported with a “targeted skills” class to increase student success.
- Designed 6-8 grade science scope & sequence, pacing documents, and used UbD to design an NGSS standards-aligned curriculum that both engaged and emerged students in phenomena-driven content.

School Culture and Safety

- Worked with equity teams and Dr. Fergus to build districtwide equity goals. At the building level, we focused on addressing bias in student and staff handbooks. Analyzed discipline data and turn keyed PD to infuse restorative practices for student discipline.
- Presented professional development for new teachers on classroom management strategies to correct student behaviors while fostering relationships and building a “Home Team” management style.
- Worked with the character education committee to plan and implement a club fair to broaden access to club participation for students who do not typically engage in extracurricular activities, which increased club participation by over 20% for the 2021/22 school year.
- Collaborated with the safety committee to analyze building-based protocols and suggest improvements for the implementation of new safety protocols to meet new COVID Safe Standards.
- Designed professional development with Social Emotional Learning (SEL) strategies for the staff to use with students with a focus on anxiety, including strategies to help support academically excelled learners in high-pressure learning environments to build resilient practices.

Personnel Management

- Designed a New teacher academy for a structured four-year mentoring program to support new staff and increase the retention of teachers.
- Created and led the Be Well, Staff Mental Health Support committee to support the various needs of our staff during the pandemic including starting an informational blog with staff guest writers, and hosting a staff “lunch bunch” to increase community building.
- Designer & Chair of PLC on building an incentive-based work system for disengaged urban youth to effectively inspire motivation towards graduation.
- Collaborated and designed the science department budget for the 2018-22 school years. Implemented a new inventory system to support teachers with shared resources and decrease spending by 38%.
- Collaborated and helped organize Professional development day using the Ed Camp model for engaging staff across both receiving and sending districts to increase articulation between schools and districts.

Community Relations

- Collaborated as a member of the Countywide Career and Technical Education (CTE) consortium to help expand health science CTE access to include middle school programs with access to RVCC programming and Teacher support.
- Founding member and leader of the Somerset County Future Administrators roundtable and professional learning group reaching over 100 aspiring leaders with panel discussions, collaborative professional learning, resume development, and practice in job scenarios.
- Built partnerships with community leaders and stakeholders to organize dropoff locations for donations and help focus funding to support recent flood victims after Hurricane Ida.
